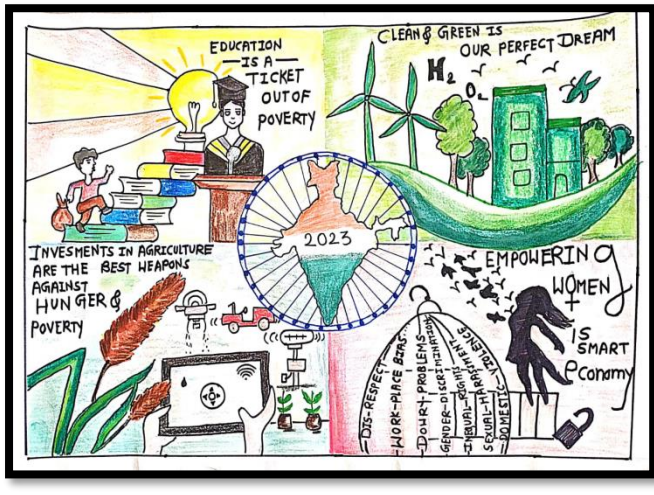
A visual display of current states of community knowledge of an issue, community expectations and visions
